<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Written approval from Buildings Accessibility and Fire & Life Safety (if applicable) (<i>see Government Modernization and Service Delivery section below</i>)	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Once all information is collected, an inspection may be conducted prior to a final decision on your application
